MSgt Raymond Ryan is a trainer in the training section at 103 Security Forces Squadron. Responsibilities are to develop, manage and execute training for all Security Forces personnel to ensure they are proficient in their duties. Key duties include ensuring compliance with training requirements, developing and revising course material, scheduling and conducting training. Ensure all personnel complete annual training requirements and maintain proficiency to meet mission readiness requirements.

MSgt Ryan enlisted in the U.S. Air Force Active Duty in January 2006. He attended Air Force BMT in May 2006, followed by the Security Forces Academy at the 343rd Training Squadron. His background includes various duties across the full spectrum of Security Forces operations ranging from internal security response team leader, Squad Leader, Base Defense Operation Controller, Unit Career Advisor.
